This is to assess their level of reading, writing, spelling and or arithmetic and will lead to the Individual Learning Programme which is specific to the learner. • If the learner says that they think, they may be dyslexic, they are screened. The screening helps to assess particular concerns, so that the learner can be made aware of coping strategies. • We also offer Dyslexic Awareness training to any organisation which can be half-day training or even a full day for staff members .

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We deliver training to anyone who is over 16 years of age with no upper age limit. • Referrals can be from any organisation within Glasgow or individuals can refer themselves. • All learning is free of cost to the learner who requires support with reading, writing, spelling and or arithmetic, regardless of whether they want to gain employment, to enter training or Further Education (college or university).
